Children must enroll for a minimum of 4 weeks for summer camp.

**The children will have multiple fun adventures for the summer. These activities will be on-site and off-site, as well as materials to cover special projects. The fee will be \$7 a week and that will cover all expenses that will be incurred. Activity fees are non-refundable. Please be sure to check your calendars before selecting your weeks. A thirty day notice is required to drop a week. If you miss the departure time of an activity, you will be responsible for transporting your child to that location. Your child will not be able to go to another classroom.**

Any registration for less than the minimum 4 weeks will not be taken until after May 31st. The cost per week will be \$225.00
